



THE NEXT LEVEL QUALIFICATION

T Levels are equivalent to A Levels and prepare students aged 16 to 18 to progress into skilled employment, an apprenticeship or higher education. The courses are designed to offer knowledge-based learning and on-the-job experience through an industry placement of 45 days (315 hours).

T Level students will spend 80% of the course in their learning environment, gaining the skills that employers need. The other 20% in a meaningful industry placement, where they put these skills into action.

T Levels will provide a mixture of:

- Knowledge based learning and practical skills specific to your chosen industry or occupation
- An industry placement of at least 45 days (315 hours) in your chosen industry or occupation
- Relevant digital skills as well as maths and English
- Common workplace skills




